The new Church year begins at sundown on November 28

December 19: The Readings of the Christmas Season

Christmas begins on December 24 and continues through January 10

January 9: The Gospel of Mark

Mark is the Gospel of Liturgical Year B (2021)

February 13: The Readings of Lent

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 17

March 27: The Readings of Holy Week and the Triduum

March 28 is Palm Sunday; the Triduum begins at sundown on Holy Thursday, April 1

April 17: The Readings of the Easter Season

Easter begins on the night of April 3 and continues through Pentecost Sunday, May 23

Fr. Felix Just, S.J., is a scripture scholar and educator who is the founder and Director of Living Word Catholic Biblical Ministries, based in Los Angeles. A frequent public lecturer, educator and retreat director in California and nationally, he brings a wide variety of scriptural themes to life for adult learners, and especially those who serve in Church ministry. Fr. Just received his Ph.D. in New Testament Studies from Yale University, has taught at Loyola Marymount and other universities, and regularly leads biblical pilgrimages to the Holy Land and sites of early Christianity. A member of the editorial board for the revision of the New Testament of the New American Bible, he has produced seven audio-CD biblical education programs with "Now You Know Media" (renamed as "Learn25").
